#### Present Quality Work:

Ensure your submissions are polished and thoughtful. Even if it's a draft, it should reflect your best effort at that point in time.

## Show Accountability:

Take ownership of your responsibilities. If something isn't clear or seems challenging, communicate it openly rather than leave it incomplete.

### Ask Questions:

Curiosity is your superpower. Don't hold back on asking even the most basic questions. If it matters to you, it's worth discussing.

#### Be Open to Feedback:

Critique is a stepping stone, not a setback. Be receptive to suggestions and constructive feedback—they're meant to sharpen your vision and execution.

## Share Your Wins and Challenges:

Celebrate milestones, no matter how small, and communicate hurdles so we can tackle them together. Progress thrives on transparency.

## Mindset and Enthusiasm

#### Show Enthusiasm:

Bring energy and positivity to our sessions. Your attitude sets the tone and inspires creativity, collaboration, and mutual respect.

#### Be Proactive:

Take the initiative to explore tools like ChatGPT, Midjourney, and NotebookLM independently. Experimentation enhances learning and demonstrates commitment. I (Craig) openly use AI and use this to push our interactions together and propel your business!

Success takes time. Be patient, persistent, and adaptable as we build your startup's foundation.
